Description

The Thomas Halliday plaque of the Duke of Wellington is a notable example of 19th-century commemorative art. Crafted by Halliday, a skilled medallist and engraver, the plaque honours Arthur Wellesley, the famed British military leader and later Prime Minister. It features a detailed relief portrait of Wellington, capturing his stern yet commanding presence.

Halliday's work is celebrated for its precision and depth, bringing a lifelike quality to metal. Such plaques served both as tributes and as collectible artefacts, reflecting Victorian admiration for military heroism and national pride.
