Description

A vibrant oil-on-canvas still life by the renowned French artist Jean Grimal (1942-1997), depicting an abundant arrangement of fruit beside a richly decorated Dutch bowl. Signed by the artist, the painting is a characterful example of Grimal's instinctive approach to colour, texture, and everyday subject matter.

The composition is animated by the contrast between the rounded, richly coloured fruit and the patterned ceramic bowl, with lively brushwork giving the scene a sense of warmth and immediacy. Grimal's handling of paint brings a decorative energy to this familiar domestic subject, balancing bold colour with an appealingly informal, expressive touch.

The work was retailed by Omell Galleries, Piccadilly, London, a respected dealer in modern and contemporary art. Its gallery provenance adds to the appeal of this attractive signed painting.

A lively and accessible work by a notable 20th-century French artist, ideally suited to a dining room, kitchen, or interior needing a confident splash of colour. It would also make a considered addition to a collection of French post-war or modern still-life painting.
