Studio pottery refers to handmade ceramic pieces created by individual artisans in their own studios, rather than mass-produced in factories. These potters emphasise artistic expression and craftsmanship, often experimenting with forms, textures, and glazes. Each piece is unique, reflecting the potter's personal style and techniques.

Studio pottery is often both functional and decorative, blending art and utility. The movement emerged in the 20th century as a response to industrialisation, promoting individuality and artisanal work in ceramics.
