A perfectly worn 19th century turned wooden salting bowl.

Salting bowls were used for preserving food, particularly meats, by adding salt to them. The salt helped inhibit bacterial growth, extending the food's shelf life. Typically made of wood, ceramic, or metal, these bowls were essential in pre-refrigeration times for storing and seasoning food, especially in large quantities.
