Description

19th century Irish blackthorn walking cane.

Irish canes made from the blackthorn tree (*Prunus spinosa*), are renowned for their durability and cultural significance. These sturdy walking sticks were historically used for self-defence, symbolising strength and resilience. Known as "shillelaghs," they feature a naturally gnarled appearance, often with a polished handle.

Blackthorn canes remain popular for both practical use and as heritage symbols of Ireland.
