

French Retro 18ct Gold and Diamond Ring, Circa 1940

Description

A striking French Retro ring in 18ct yellow gold, dating to the 1940s and centred on an impressive old mine-cut diamond of approximately 1 carat. Bold in scale yet elegant in profile, it is a fine example of the confident, sculptural jewellery that came to define the French Retro period.

The warm yellow gold setting provides a sumptuous contrast to the diamond's soft, distinctive brilliance. Unlike modern round brilliant cuts, the old mine cut has a gently cushion-shaped outline, a higher crown, and broad hand-cut facets that create a lively, romantic sparkle. Its character and individuality give the ring a wonderful sense of history, perfectly suited to the richness of the 1940s design.

French Retro jewellery emerged during a period when designers embraced substantial gold work, sweeping curves, and dramatic proportions. With platinum in restricted supply during the war years, jewellers made especially expressive use of yellow and rose gold, producing designs with strength, warmth, and undeniable glamour. This ring reflects that aesthetic beautifully: the weight and colour of the gold lend presence, while the old-cut diamond brings refinement and light.

A sophisticated and highly wearable period jewel, this ring would make a distinctive alternative engagement ring or a superb addition to a collection of French Retro jewellery. Its combination of a substantial 18ct gold setting and a diamond of approximately one carat gives it enduring appeal.
