An early 20th century Cornish serpentine lighthouse lamp.

Cornish serpentine is a unique, greenish rock found primarily on the Lizard Peninsula in Cornwall, England. Known for its vibrant shades of green, red, and brown, serpentine has been prized for centuries for its beauty and workability. It was especially popular in Victorian times when it was crafted into decorative items like vases, ornaments, and jewellery.

Rewired with brown twisted fabric flex and PAT tested.

Height excluding shade 39cm.
