Jean-Marc Nattier was an 18th-century French Rococo painter renowned for his elegant portraits of the French aristocracy. His works often depicted women in mythological or allegorical guises, blending realism with idealised beauty. Nattier's refined technique and graceful compositions made him a favourite at the court of Louis XV, immortalising the era's fashion and charm.
