His workshop, located on Pancras Road, produced a variety of ceramic items, including tableware and ornaments. Rea's work was characterised by intricate designs, such as a ginger jar featuring a moth-adorned lid and artistically crafted handles.

Beyond his pottery, Rea was also a publisher, reflecting his diverse talents and interests. His daughter, Lucy, continues his legacy, having trained in restoration techniques to preserve ceramic art. Rea's contributions to the field have left a lasting impact on the world of ceramics.
