Description

Royal Copenhagen Johannes Hedegaard pottery bust of a young lady with a multicolour glazed head scarf. Signed and limitation 159/289 to base. Circa 1950.

Johannes Hedegaard (1915-1999) was a Danish sculptor and ceramist renowned for his expressive, often figurative works. Working primarily with Royal Copenhagen, he created unique ceramic sculptures, including vases and busts, that combine modernist influences with a personal, organic style. His pieces frequently depict stylised human figures, capturing delicate expressions and emotions. Hedegaard's work is highly valued for its elegant, thoughtful craftsmanship, merging functionality with artistic sensitivity, making him a significant figure in mid-20th-century Danish ceramics.
