Description

A refined single-strand necklace of graduated cultured pearls, finished with an elegant platinum and diamond clasp, circa 1920. With its harmonious progression of softly lustrous pearls and understated early Art Deco mount, this is a timeless jewel of exceptional versatility.

The pearls graduate beautifully in size along the length of the strand, creating a balanced silhouette that sits gracefully at the neck. Their gentle creamy tone and natural iridescence bring warmth to the piece, while the platinum clasp provides a crisp, luxurious contrast. Set with diamonds, the clasp offers a discreet flash of brilliance and reflects the fine, restrained elegance associated with jewellery of the 1920s.

Pearl necklaces were central to the fashionable wardrobe of the period, admired for their ability to complement both daytime tailoring and evening dress. This example retains that same enduring appeal: sufficiently refined for formal occasions, yet simple and adaptable enough for regular wear.
