

Circa 1930 Platinum 1ct Diamond Solitaire Ring

Description

An elegant circa 1930 platinum diamond solitaire ring, centred on a beautifully bright brilliant-cut diamond of approximately 1.00 carat. Graded F colour, the principal stone has a notably crisp, colourless appearance and a lively display of brilliance.

The central diamond is framed by tapered baguette-cut diamond shoulders, which draw the eye towards the main stone while lending the ring a refined, architectural profile. This restrained geometric detail is characteristic of the period, combining the glamour of early 20th-century diamond jewellery with a clean, timeless elegance.

The platinum setting provides a cool, durable backdrop that enhances the diamonds' natural fire and sparkle. Its low-key sophistication makes the ring equally compelling as a vintage engagement ring or as an exceptional addition to a fine jewellery collection.

A beautifully balanced and highly wearable jewel, with the classic appeal of a solitaire elevated by the precision and grace of diamond-set baguette shoulders.
