

Engraved Silver-Cased Pendant, Dated 1923

Description

A charming silver-cased pendant, dated 1923, with finely engraved decoration to the front and a personal inscription to the reverse. Compact and elegantly made, it is a quietly evocative piece of early 20th-century jewellery, combining decorative craftsmanship with the intimate appeal of a named or dated keepsake.

The front is enriched with engraved ornament, lending texture and refinement to the silver surface, while the reverse bears its inscription as a lasting record of a personal occasion, relationship, or presentation. Such details transform the pendant from a decorative accessory into a small piece of social history, preserving a private message from more than a century ago.

Silver-cased pendants of this kind were often worn close to the heart and could hold a photograph, miniature, lock of hair, or other cherished memento. Whether originally given as a token of affection, a birthday or coming-of-age gift, or to mark a significant event, this example retains the sentiment and individuality that make antique personal jewellery so compelling.

The pendant has a graceful simplicity that makes it easy to wear today, while its 1923 date and engraved inscription give it genuine period character. It would make a thoughtful addition to a collection of antique silver jewellery, sentimental keepsakes, or early 20th-century personal objects.
