Description

A beautifully restrained Victorian bracelet, fashioned from deep black Whitby jet and dating to circa 1860. With its rich, mirror-like surface and unmistakable warm black tone, the bracelet is a refined example of one of the most distinctive materials in 19th-century British jewellery.

Whitby jet is a fossilised wood found along the Yorkshire coast and became especially fashionable during the Victorian period. It was prized for its lightness, ability to take a high polish, and rich black appearance. Although strongly associated with mourning jewellery, jet was also worn as a sophisticated fashionable accessory, valued for its dramatic contrast and elegant simplicity.

The bracelet's polished black elements create a graceful, wearable silhouette, giving it a quiet elegance that works as beautifully today as it did in the 19th century. Its uncomplicated design allows the natural character of the jet to take centre stage, while the rich black finish makes it an especially versatile piece for day or evening wear.
