Description

A William IV yellow gold enamel and natural pearl memory brooch containing a lock of hair dated 1833.

Memory brooches, popular in the early 19th century, were sentimental pieces of jewellery commemorating or honouring loved ones who lived during his era. These brooches often incorporated miniature portraits, locks of hair, or enamel inscriptions, serving as personal keepsakes of remembrance.
