Description

A wonderfully stylish French green swan-neck desk lamp, dating from the 1930s. With its graceful curved stem, compact shade, and richly coloured painted finish, this is a beautifully practical piece of early 20th-century design-full of warmth, character, and individuality that is simply impossible to replicate in a newly made lamp.

The elegant swan-neck form allows the light to be directed exactly where it is needed, making it ideal for a desk, bedside table, reading corner, studio, or library. Its soft green finish gives the lamp a particularly appealing presence, adding a subtle note of colour while sitting comfortably within both traditional and contemporary interiors.

French lighting of this period is admired for its balance of function and style: made for everyday use, yet designed with a confident, sculptural simplicity. This example has the pleasing proportions and genuine age that make antique lighting so rewarding to live with. Its original character has been retained, while the electrical components have been thoughtfully updated for modern use.

The lamp has been professionally rewired with twisted fabric-covered flex, chosen to complement its period appearance, and has been PAT tested. It is ready to bring a distinctive, atmospheric glow to its next setting.
