

Railway Locomotive Wall Clock with Luminous Dial

## Description

An unusual and highly decorative brass and iron railway clock, originally fitted to a locomotive and later adapted for wall display. Its substantial industrial case, large dial, and practical design give it the unmistakable presence of authentic railway equipment, while the aged materials and working patina lend it considerable character.

The generously proportioned dial retains its luminous numerals and hands, designed for clear legibility in the low-light conditions of a locomotive cab. Set within a robust brass bezel and iron body, the clock has a compelling blend of utilitarian engineering and sculptural appeal. Its later wall-fixing arrangement allows it to be displayed easily as an interior focal point.

The original mechanical movement has, at some point, been replaced with a modern quartz movement. Although this means it is no longer mechanically original, the alteration provides reliable, straightforward timekeeping and does not diminish the visual impact or fascinating railway provenance of the case and dial.

A striking piece for a railway enthusiast, collector of industrial antiques, or anyone seeking an original statement clock for a kitchen, study, hall, bar, or loft-style interior.
